The Cathedral Council of Catholic Women and the Knights of Columbus Council #16126 are offering scholarships to students who are (1) registered members of the Cathedral parish and (2) attending a Catholic high school or entering 7th or 8th grade at a Catholic grade school in the fall of 2019.

- Scholarship funds are generated by parish events sponsored by the two organizations.
- All applications are reviewed by the scholarship committee using the following weighted percentages:

50%	Parish service, participation, and mass attendance
25%	One Page Essay
25%	Teacher evaluations
- Scholarship application packets may be picked up in the school office at all the Catholics grade schools in Springfield, the SHG office or in the Cathedral Rectory.
- Return your completed Scholarship Application and essay to the Cathedral Rectory by **noon Wednesday, May 15, 2019**. *There will be no exceptions.*
- All decisions of the committee are final. Notification of awards will be mailed by the committee.
- If you are selected as a scholarship recipient, we will remit your scholarship funds directly to your school in August.

**Applications without all required information will not be considered for a scholarship.*
